



Supporting documents for the transfer of human remains of Cypriot citizens deceased abroad to Cyprus

Documents	
1	Certified and translated death certificate from the authorities of the country where the deceased has passed
2	Certified and translated certificate from the competent authority, confirming that the body has been carefully placed in a welded lead or zinc coffin, with an outer wooden coffin of at least 20mm thickness
3	Certified and translated permit to transport the body from the competent authorities of the country of departure
4	Certified and translated certificate from the authorities of the country where the deceased has passed, confirming that there was no epidemic or contagious disease in the area, where the deceased died
5	Certified affidavit from a representative of the funeral home stating that the embalming process has been carried out/ If the body has been cremated, then a certified cremation certificate must be presented in place of the embalming certificate. The transporter of the ashes is obliged to take all measures for their safe packaging.
6	Certified statement from the funeral home confirming the itinerary
7	Certified copy of the first page of the deceased's passport
